WHAT WILL I BE DOING?

The duties of adults in the camp depend upon the activity.

- 1. Help supervise the boys while you are in camp.
- 2. Horseshoes/Washers: This may include watching the boys, limiting horseplay, keeping score, and keeping the boys safely out of harms way.

NOTE: You do not have to know the rules; there are leaders present who can assist in this area.
